Types of Evaluations

- Multidisciplinary initial evaluation for school district Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE)
- Core evaluation for Early Intervention
- Supplemental (when child is observed to have an additional area of need)
- Autism Spectrum Disorder evaluations for Preschool
